46

- Sends a Letter to M. Crassus, Quaestor of the Bellovaci, staying the winter nearby
- He then sends a letter to C. Fabius to enter the Atrebates' territory and to Labienus to join him on the borders of Nervii territory
- He doesn't wait for these men, but takes about 400 horses from the nearest winter-quarters

47

- He meets up with Crasus and gives him control of the legion he's leaving behind along with all the impediments and baggage.
- Fabius catches up with him
- Labienus laments his inability to leave his own winter quarters due to fear of being overtaken due to the harsh climate and recent losses

48

- Caesar was disappointed by Labienus, but didn't blame him for being holed up
- Arrives at the territory of the Nervii and learns how much Cicero is failing (remember that's not our hated Cicero)
- He sends Cicero a letter in Greek which due to a hilarious* sequence of events was not received until almost when Caesar's foreces were visible.
