 - ❖ Erant - 3rd pl impf act indic
 - ❖ in Thessaliā - ABL SG PLACE WHERE
 - ❖ duō frātrēs - NOM PL SUBJ/PRED
- ❖ quōrum alter Aesōn, alter Peliās appellābātur.
 - ❖ quōrum - GEN PL POSSESSION
 - ❖ alter Aesōn, - NOM SG SUBJ
 - ❖ alter Peliās - NOM SG SUBJ
 - ❖ appellābātur - 3RD SG IMPF PASS INDIC

 - ❖ frātre suū - ACC SG DIR OBJ
 - ❖ expulit, - 3RD SG PERF ACT INDIC

 - ❖ in animo = ABL SG PLACE WHERE
 - ❖ habēbat = 3RD SG IMPF ACT INDIC
 - ❖ Iāsonem = ACC SG DIR
 - ❖ Aesonis = GEN SG POSS
 - ❖ filiū = ACC SG agrees with Iasonem
 - ❖ interficere = PRES ACT INFIN

 - ❖ ē tantō perīculō - ABL SG PLACE FROM WHICH
 - ❖ ēripere - PRES ACT INFIN
 - ❖ cōstituērunt. - PERF ACT INDIC 3RD PL

- ❖ **Noctū igitur lāsonem ex urbe abstulērunt,**
 - ❖ Noctū - ADV
 - ❖ igitur - ADV
 - ❖ lāsonem - ACC SG DIR OBJ
 - ❖ ex urbe - ABL SG PLACE FROM WHICH
 - ❖ abstulērunt, - PERF ACT INDIC 3RD PL
- ❖ **et [cum posterō diē ad rēgem rediissent,]**
 - ❖ [cum...rediissent] —> “cum” clause, “cum” = “when”
 - ❖ [cum =CONJ] = WHEN
 - ❖ posterō diē - ABL SG TIME WHEN
 - ❖ ad rēgem - ACC SG PLACE TO WHICH
 - ❖ rediissent, = 3RD PL PLUPF ACT SUBJU

Part B - ANALYSIS (Continued)

- ❖ **eī renūntiāvērunt [puerum mortuum esse.]**
 - ❖ eī - DAT SG IND OBJ w/renuntiaverunt
 - ❖ renūntiāvērunt = PERF ACT INDIC 3RD PL
 - ❖ [puerum...esse] —> indirect statement
 - ❖ puerum = ACC SG SUBJ of the indirect statement
 - ❖ mortuum = ACC SG describing *puerum*
 - ❖ esse - PRES ACT INFIN
