

Fio, fieri, factus – to become, to be made

irregular verb → represents the PASSIVE voice of *facio* *** Does NOT LOOK passive in the pres, impf, and fut tenses. ***Uses the 4th PRINCIPAL PART of *facio* in the perf, plupf, and fut perf. Thus, it can be considered a SEMI-deponent verb.
