

NOTES: INDIRECT STATEMENT (Jenney Lesson 39 P. 223)**DIRECT STATEMENT VS. INDIRECT STATEMENT in English**

Direct Speech/Statement → Saying exactly what someone has said; involves quotation marks.

E.G. He says, "Caesar is brave."

Indirect Speech/Statement → used to report what someone has said; involves reporting verbs (e.g., 'say', 'tell', 'ask'); can involve 'that' to introduce the reported words. *Does not involve quotation marks or inverted commas.*

E.G. He says that Caesar is brave.
