SECONDARY Sequence

If VERB of MENTAL ACTION is IMPF, PERF, or PLUPF
 PRES Infin in ind. statemt → translates as IMPF/PERF
 PERF Infin in ind. statemt → translates as PLUPERFECT
 FUT Infin in ind. statemt → translates as “WOULD”
